Benefits of PPM



Neutral



- Maintain important connections for children
- Facilitate communication and collaboration between birth and adopting families
- Create helpful boundaries for children's well-being
- Expedite permanency when possible and appropriate
- Available at no cost to counties and families
- Re-mediation available if an agreement is reached, until the child is 18 years old

Mediation is Available for:

- Birth Relatives
- Siblings
- Prospective Permanent Family
- Native American Tribe
- Former Foster Parents
- CASAs

- Must be submitted at least 75 days prior* to TPR at the 366.26 Hearing (Selection and Implementation) for birth family, tribe, and other important adult connections
- Must be submitted at least 4 months prior to finalization for sibling contact
